

Suggested OPIRG Windsor Bylaw Amendment

Previous

19.1 In the event that more than 50% of the OPIRG-Windsor members obtain a fee refund in any given year, OPIRG-Windsor shall be declared dissolved, and shall be subject to the provision of Article 19.2

Amendment Suggested

19.1 In the event that more than 50% of OPIRG Windsor members obtain a membership fee refund in Fall and Winter school terms of the same fiscal year a dissolution process will be triggered. OPIRG Windsor shall launch a 1-fiscal year membership research campaign to gather the feedback and opinions of students, both member and non-member. This will be to develop an understanding of membership retention and possible direction forward. The membership fee refund during the year of membership retention research will not be counted.

The results and planned actions will be presented during a Fall Term Meeting of the Members, post 1 fiscal year of membership research, and implemented that Fall and Winter term. If in following year post implementation of the membership retention research, more than 50% of the OPIRG-Windsor members obtain a fee refund in Fall and Winter school terms of the same fiscal year, OPIRG-Windsor shall be declared dissolved, and shall be subject to the provision of Article 19.2

Example timeline for above

1. Fall 2019 and Winter 2020 more than 50% opt out each term triggers Dissolution Process
2. Fall 2020 and Winter 2021 Membership research campaign
3. Fall 2021 and Winter 2022 Presentation and implementation of membership campaign outcomes
4. Fall 2022 and Winter 2023 Over 50% opt out remains per school term
5. End of Winter 2023 Dissolution of OPIRG Windsor
